The band is available as either a 5 piece band with Female and Male vocals, or a 4 piece band with Male vocals. This enables the band to adapt to stage space limitations, and most importantly, adapt to the budget of the client.

The 5 Piece band line up consists of Julie Maguire – Female Lead Vocals, Guy Watson – Male Lead Vocals/Guitar, Simon Horn – Bass Guitar/Backing Vocals, Pete Billington – Keyboards,/Backing Vocals, and Toby Goodman – Drums. The 4 piece band is the same line up without Female vocals.

The playlist is always organised on the night, and is always varied to cater for the age range of the audience, and the songs that we know will get people up and dancing.
