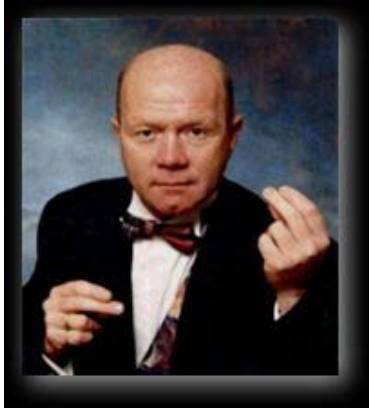


Rod Stevens
